The Southern Park County Fire Protection District (SPCFPD) is pleased to announce its selection as a recipient of a monetary grant from the **Colorado Fire Relief Fund-The Denver Foundation**. The grant, in the amount of \$3,329, will be used to replenish supplies and to effect repairs and maintenance to one of the District's Type 6 Wildfire trucks which was used to help fight fires in Colorado during the rash of wildfires earlier this year.

The grants were made available, through **The Colorado Fire Relief Fund**, to help volunteer fire departments across Colorado to replenish depleted supplies and small equipment to help insure that the fire districts are prepared to fight future fires. The main criteria for eligibility is that the Departments were directly involved in fighting Colorado wildfires during 2012

The Southern Park County Fire District's Firefighters and apparatus participated in combating **the High Park, Little Sand, Springer Fire, Lower North Fork, and the Arkansas Fire in Lake George**. The SPCFPD extends its thanks to the Colorado Fire Relief fund and to those who contributed to the Fund for this generous grant.
