- **WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of the Southern Park County Fire Protection District, has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 5th, 2024 and;
- **WHEREAS**, the amount of money necessary to balance to budget for the general operating purposes from property taxes of **\$624,363.69** and:
- **WHEREAS**, the 2024 valuation for assessment for the Southern Park County Fire Protection District as certified by the County Assessor **is \$50,885,386**.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SOUTHERN PARK COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT COLORADO:
- Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Southern Park County Fire Protection District during the 2021 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 12.27 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Southern Park County Fire Protection District for the year 2025.
- Section 2. That the Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Park County Colorado, the mill levies for the Southern Park County Fire Protection District as hereinabove determined and set, or be authorized and directed to certify to the County Commissioners of Park County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Southern Park County Fire Protection District as hereinabove determined and set, but as recalculated as needed upon receipt of the final (November) certification and valuation from the county assessor in order to comply with any applicable revenue and other budgetary limits.
